

As we move forward, we want to take some time to look back and recognize some of the organizations and people that help Young Leaders, Strong City, do the necessary work we've been able to do. Some of our accomplishments in that work included expanding our team, conducting over 25 programs for students, and hosting upwards of 150 students at our 9th annual Teen Equity Summit, which without funders like these below, none of this would be possible.

- W.W. Caruth Fund, Jr. Fund \$75k was awarded for two years, 2021 and 2022. Funds will go to growing YLSC's staff, outreach efforts, and Teen Equity summit
- United Way YLSC was awarded a three-year grant that will go to fund our Youth Advisory Council, monthly and special sessions about the history of communities to inform narratives along with community service projects
- PNC Bank Funds will go to develop YLSC's Race and Money curriculum, which includes; financial literacy focused on saving, investing, buying stocks, budgeting, debt, and avoiding impulse purchases
- Santander Foundation Funds will go to help YLSC bring on additional team members, expand our outreach endeavors, and enhance the Teen Equity Summit
- The Allstate Foundation \$100k was awarded for two years, 2022 and 2023, to enhance YLSC's youth leaders' racial equity cohort
